amazing facts about the unborn baby...

From the time of fertilization, a baby's unique DNA and genetic makeup are complete from sex to hair colour to height as an adult



By 10 weeks the baby's brain and other major organs are formed and functional



at 13 weeks, the unborn baby has a unique set of fingertips



at 4 weeks the embryo's eyes and ears begin to form

At 24 weeks, unborn babies can survive outside the womb



The unborn baby has a beating heart at 3 weeks

The arms and legs are clearly visible at 8 weeks



At birth babies have 300 separate bones, 94 more than mom and dad!



At 12 weeks, the unborn weighs about 0.5 ounces, about the same as an iPod Shuffle

After 8 weeks the baby is called a "fetus" meaning "little one" in Latin



The fetus is 12 inches long at 20 weeks
